- **“A young man came to us who’d been living at the bus station. Obviously, he hadn’t showered, had a chance to brush his teeth or even shave. And the dignity he got back - to actually be able to clean himself up - to shave, to brush his teeth...he got emotional. The impact is, when you feel better about yourself, you’re able to make better choices. It’s those little things that can change the entire trajectory of a life.”** – Crisis Shelter
- **“Seeing the smiles on the faces of our students as we give them feminine hygiene products is heartwarming. Some of the girls had no access to these things and had to find other ways to handle that time of the month. They are now able to use proper supplies and feel clean and confident each day.
